

## SAFETY RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) **YOUR BALANCE AT ALL TIMES:**
  - a) Passengers must behave safely at all times.
  - b) It is important to always hold the metal safety ramps fixed on the sides of the boat when moving on boat from the back to the front. Side cables are not for holding yourself.
  - c) When the boat bell rings, sit immediately or hold on something sturdy, it means that a large waves will shake the boat and may cause significant imbalances for passengers.
  - d) Pay attention to the deck if it is wet following a rain or swimming, it is very slippery.
  
- 2) **LIFE JACKETS:** All life jackets are in the front room of the boat. Passengers who are afraid of the water or don't know how to swim must have a life jacket nearby or wear it to get to the front of the boat.
  
- 3) **LIFEBUOY:** If someone would fall into the water, immediately throw the rear lifebuoy and shout to warn the captain
  
- 4) **RESPECT FOR THE STRUCTURE OF THE BOAT**
  - a) It is forbidden to jump on the boat.
  - b) A boat is not as strong as a house, so the weight of the passengers must be logically distributed on the boat. The rule of 6 must be respected. So never more than 6 people for the following places: the front bench; the roof in the middle of the boat; the front of the bench; in the cockpit and inside the boat.
  - c) It also goes without saying that it is also necessary to distribute the weight of the passengers on the left and right side of the boat so that the boat does not lean unnecessarily to one side.
  
- 5) **TOILET:** It is forbidden to put toilet paper, plastic or any other thing in the toilet, this would have the effect of blocking it and making it unusable for the duration of the cruise. A trash can is nearby for papers or other. In addition, very little water must be added to facilitate pumping. The septic tank has a limited capacity that must be maximized to ensure that there will be no problem for the duration of the cruise.
  
- 6) **ALWAYS BEHAVE:** no unpleasant or dangerous behaviours will be tolerated during the cruise. If necessary, the Coast Guard or the Nautical Police will be called for removing the passenger(s) deemed dangerous by the captain.
  
- 7) **FOOD AND BEVERAGES:** It is allowed to eat and drink everywhere on the boat, both inside and outside. On the other hand, you must secure your beverages and make sure not to spill anything on the boat, cushions or blankets. Cleaning due to food and beverages is the responsibility of the group.
  
- 8) **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** They are allowed but in moderation. Clarity of mind in the event of an emergency and a sense of balance should not be affected as this would increase the risk of an accident.
  
- 9) **CIGARETTE:** it is allowed to smoke only at the front of the boat outside paying close attention to the cushions and deck of the boat. The use of ashtrays is mandatory. The lake is not an ashtray!
  
- 10) **CLEANING AT THE END OF THE CRUISE:** The cleaning at the end of the cruise is the responsibility of the group.
  
- 11) **DOMAGES:** each passenger is responsible for any damage that he may cause to the boat or its accessories.
